<u>Venetian Village</u>, Park Shore drive, 1 mile west of US 41. Right on the water.

Promenade shops, west side of US 41, 7 miles north of Vanderbilt Beach Rd.

<u>Old Naples</u>, 5th Ave S and on <u>3rd St</u> between 11th and 13th Ave S, 9 miles from Piper's Grove. Many restaurant, bars, and shops. Nice places to walk.

Activity ideas (listed from closest to farthest)

Bike to lunch.

- (a) Vanderbilt Collection, NW corner of Airport-Pulling and Vanderbilt Beach Rd.
- **(b)** Take Airport Rd 1.5 miles south to Naples Blvd. Nearby are <u>Miller's Naples Ale House</u>, Thai-Thai, Chick-fil-A, Culver's, Cold Stone Creamery, and several other places.
- (c) Take Airport Rd 2 miles north to Greentree Plaza, just before Immokalee Rd; several places open for lunch <u>Joey D's</u>, Boston Beer Garden, LuLu B's, Planet Smoothie.
- (d) Take Vanderbilt Beach Rd 2.5 miles west to the entrance of Mercato; Whole Foods cafe and many restaurants and bars, many open late.
- *Collier County Regional Park*. 2 miles, on Livingston Rd north of Vanderbilt Beach Rd. <u>Sun-N-Fun Lagoon Water park</u>, gym, playground, tables, fields, boardwalk, 2 mile bike path.
- **Vanderbilt Beach** (3.5 miles) is a 10 minute drive or 35 min bike ride down Vanderbilt Beach Rd. Parking garage on the left (free if you are using a car with a Collier Beach Pass).
- *Freedom park.* 5 miles. North side of Golden Gate parkway just east of Goodlette-Frank Rd. Paved walkway, boardwalks. (No bikes on boardwalk). Free.
- <u>Greenway</u>, 5 miles. near Golden Gate Pky and Goodlette-Frank Rd. Boardwalk and paved trail for walkers and bikers, along the Gordon river, Restrooms, Kayak Launch, picnic tables.
- <u>Cocohatchee River Marina</u>, 6 miles from Piper's Grove. US 41, 1 mile north of Immokalee Rd., Nature cruises, canoes, kayaks, Phone (239) 592-1200.
- <u>Clam Pass</u>, long boardwalk to the beach, with a free shuttle. <u>Rhodes's Inn</u> serves drinks and bar snacks with nice sunset views. 6 miles. Take Pine Ridge/ Rd, all the way west to the end.
- *Nature Conservancy*, 7 miles from Piper's Grove, has hands-on exhibits, guided electric boat tours, a wildlife rehabilitation center, nature trails, kayak, and canoe rentals. Off Goodlette-Frank Rd, south of the Zoo. Phone 262-0304.
- *Baker park*. New park with nice views, bike and walking paths, playground, picnic areas, kayak ramp. 7 miles. Take Goodlette-Frank south, left on Central Ave. Connects to the Greenway. https://www.naplesgov.com/parksrec/page/baker-park-now-open
- <u>Delnor-Wiggins Pass State Park</u>, 11135 Gulf Shore. 7 miles. Take on Immokalee Rd/.111th St all the way west to the end. \$6 parking fee. Beaches, restrooms, and short boardwalk.
- *Naples Botanical Garden*, 10 miles from Piper's Grove, has *acres* of beautiful tropical plants, water features, etc. Very nice café and gift shop. South on Airport Rd, right on Davis Blvd, left on Shadowlawn (becomes Bayshore Dr after crossing US 41), right after Thomasson Rd. \$20 entrance fee for non-members.
- <u>Sugden Regional Park</u>, Waterfront park and paved trail around Lake; freshwater beach, water skiing and sailing classes. 10 Miles: South on US 41, right on Lakewood Dr. Free.
- <u>Barefoot Beach Preserve</u>, 13 miles from Piper's Grove. Beautiful beach for driftwood, shelling, annotated nature path, guided canoe trips, Take US 41 north, left at Bonita Beach Rd (865), left on Barefoot Beach Blvd to the entrance (\$8 entrance fee unless you have a Beach Pass).
- <u>Lovers Key State Park</u>, 15 miles from Piper's Grove. Very nice beach island for shelling, bike paths, chair, umbrella, canoe and bike rentals, concession stand, shaded picnic gazebo, charcoal grills. Take US 41 north, left at Bonita Beach Rd (865), drive 7 miles and turn left at the entrance sign (\$5 vehicle entrance fee). A free tram takes you from the parking lot to the beach.
- **Bird Rookery Swamp Trail**, 17 miles from Piper's Grove, 1295 Shady Hollow Boulevard, Naples, FL 34120. 12 miles of hiking and biking trails, including a 1500-ft. boardwalk with wheelchair accessibility. Picnic tables near parking lot. Lots of birds. Free.

- **Koreshan State Historic Site**, 17 miles. This site of a bizarre 19th century religious community has interesting story, architecture, and \$2 guided tour. I-75 Exit 123 Corkscrew Road, head west 2 miles, cross U.S. 41 and continue on Corkscrew Road approximately 1000 yards to entrance of park. Phone 992-0311. Parking \$5.00 per car.
- <u>6-mile Cypress Slough</u>. Boardwalk through beautiful photogenic swamp. Nature center with limited parking. \$1/hour parking. 23 miles: North on I-75, West on Daniels, right on 6-mile Cypress Parkway. Bring your camera. https://www.sloughpreserve.org/
- <u>Corkscrew Swamp Sanctuary</u>, 31 miles from Piper's Grove, a beautiful Audubon facility with a 2-mile raised boardwalk. Lots of photo opportunities. \$10 admission fee. Driving directions: take Immokalee Rd all the way east 30 miles until you see the Audubon sign, the turn left.
- <u>Sanibel Island</u>, 34 miles from Piper's Grove. World-famous beaches for shelling. Take Livingston Rd north, left at Bonita Beach Rd (865), stay on 865 all the way through Ft. Myers beach, left on Summerlin Rd to the bridge to Sanibel (\$6 toll).
- <u>Edison-Ford Home and Laboratory</u>. 34 miles. Thomas Edison's winter home and laboratory; interesting exhibits. 2350 McGregor Boulevard in Fort Myers
- "Ding" Darling National Wildlife Refuge, 44 miles, on Sanibel Island. Great for birding, biking, walking, or driving. \$10 per vehicle.
- *Williams Roadside Park*: 45 miles. Unpaved shell road into the Everglades along a canal with lots of wild alligators and birds. Go south on Airport Rd to US 41 (Tamiami Trail) then turn left and drive 36 miles. Park is on the left, 2.5 miles after the little post office in Ochopee. Also air-boat ride places along this road.
- <u>Clyde Bucher Gallery</u>. 62 miles. 52388 Tamiami Trail E, Ochopee, FL 34141. Incredible photographs by "The Ansel Adams of the Everglades". Pretty wetland setting.
- *Everglades National Park, Shark Valley.* Best place for birding. 78 miles. \$30.00 per car, \$25.00 per motorcycle, or \$15.00 per hiker/biker. Free entrance for holders of the <u>Golden Age Passport</u>. Optional guided tram ride \$25 (reservations: 305-221-8455). South on Airport Rd 8 miles to US 41, turn left and drive 70 miles. Details: https://www.sharkvalleytramtours.com/
- *Ringling Museum and Ca-d'Zan Mansion.* 110 miles from Piper's Grove. Beautiful mansion and interesting circus museum. Phone 941-359-5700. Details: http://www.ringling.org/
- *Marie Selby Botanical Gardens*, Sarasota. 110 miles. Adults \$25. (Lower fee for members of the Naples Botanical Gardens). See http://www.selby.org/
- *Miami South Beach*. 129 miles. Art deco architecture, upscale shopping, outdoor cafes offer a ringside view of the scene. Use your GPS to get to Collins Ave. Great people watching.
